I. ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. First year students, Ministerial Preparation Program, who have successfully completed three (3) classes with UUMS.
- 2. Must have the intention of becoming a Unity Minister or License Unity Teacher (LUT).

II. APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applicants must submit the following by January 31, 2026, <u>2026 Ruth Mosley Scholarship</u> Application Form

1. <u>Letter of Application</u>: A letter containing the applicant's biography, photo and statement of intent to become a Unity Minister or a LUT.

2. Three (3) letters of recommendation from:

- a) Applicant's Minister/Spiritual Leader
- b) A person within the applicant's spiritual community
- c) A person of applicant's choice.

3. Response to Questions:

Give brief responses to the following questions. Using 250 total words or less across all questions.

A. Community Service/ Making a Difference

What are you doing to uplift your spiritual community? What outside organizations and activities do you serve and why?

B. UUMS Guiding Scripture

Isaiah 61:1 (KJV) "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound."

This is the foundational scripture of UUMS. What does this scripture mean to you? As an aspiring Minister or LUT, how will you apply this in your ministry?

C. Personal Guiding Scripture

In this moment of your life, what is your guiding scripture? How is this scripture guiding you?

D. Prosperity Consciousness

Describe your prosperity consciousness. Give examples.

E. Prayer Practice

Tell us about your prayer practices.

III. IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE APPLICATION

- 1. Completed applications must be received by January 31, 2026.
- 2. A confirmation receipt of the application will be sent to the applicant after submission.
- 3. Entries will be reviewed and recipients selected by the Scholarship Committee.
- 4. Recipients will be notified by February 28, 2026.
- 5. Amounts will be based on available funds.
- 6. All funds will be applied to tuition only for the Summer Term 2026 Spring Term 2027.
- 7. Please note that you must upload all required application components at the time of submission, all in one file.
- 8. Incomplete, late applications, and applying for incorrect scholarships will not be considered.
- 9. Applications received after January 31, 2026 will not be accepted.
