The Old Testament: An Introduction to the Hebrew Bible, 2nd Edition, Harris, Stephen L. and Platzner, Robert L. McGraw Hill, Boston; 2008. This is an excellent historical-critical treatment of the OT. Students who have taken the OT classes in the past should have the Harris & Platzner, *The Old Testament*, text which has a full chapter on the Apocrypha. (This is still a required text in two of the OT classes)

This is a keeper reference book. Reading assignments are from the page number of the 2nd edition so you may need to do some looking for the material in later or earlier editions. If you opt for an electronic version, try for one with page numbers and locations, even then you may have to do some looking for the pages referenced in the reading assignment, but...you are Bible detectives!

NRSV version of the Bible, (Preferably - The New Oxford Annotated Bible with Apocrypha) Metzger, Bruce M. & Roland E. Murphy, Editors; Oxford University Press, New York, 1994.) There are excellent commentaries on the Apocrypha and on the various books of the Apocrypha. This material is placed between the Old Testament books and the New Testament. Some discussion material may be drawn from this material. This was the Bible I was required to have for ministerial school and for my SEE/CEP classes. I believe that UWSI still suggest this version of the NRSV Bible. You should probably have this already.

If you already have another Annotated Bible of another publisher, use what you have and note which Bible you are using.
